# **NOMINATION & BALLOTING NOTICE**

Nominations for Local 500 Officers open on: and will remain open until:

Monday, October 21, 2019, 8 AM Friday, November 8, 2019, 5 PM

The following positions are open:

1	President	2-year term
2	<b>Business Agents</b>	2-year term
1	Despatch Coordinator	2-year term
1	Trustee	2-year term
10	<b>Executive Members</b>	2-year term

## Article V Officers & Committee Members, D. Elections, Sections 3, 4, & 5 state the following:

Members qualified to nominate and vote shall be all Members in good Section 3. standing (exclusive of probationary members).

Members NOT qualified to be nominated for office shall be those Section 4. Members who:

- a) are not in good standing as of close of nominations, or
- b) have not been a Member for one (1) full year as of close of nominations, or
- c) within the year previous to the election date have been convicted of "Conduct Detrimental to the Union" or have been recalled from office, or
- d) have been appointed to the Balloting Committee, or
- e) have a current application to become a Foreman or Agent of the Employer,
- f) are over the age of 65 years or who would turn 65 years of age during their term in office or who are in receipt of the Industry Pension.

No member may be a candidate for more than one (1) Local Office. An Office Holder (three titled Officers, Despatchers and Business Agents) who wishes to be a candidate for another Local Office shall resign from the Office and make it known prior to nominations opening. However, any candidate for office shall be allowed to run on ballot for Delegates to Conventions and/or Caucuses and for the ILWU Canada/Longshore Contract Executive Board.

Nomination forms are available at the Union Office. One nomination form for every position that you are running for. This will also include candidates choice for scrutineers. Qualification for scrutineer will follow Article V (D), Elections Section 3 & 4 of the Constitution. All candidates will be introduced at the Annual Meeting to be held on Wednesday, November 20, 2019. A list of nominees will be available to VIEW at the Union Office as nominations are submitted.
