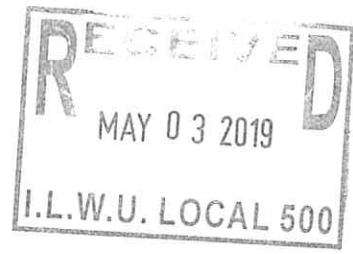

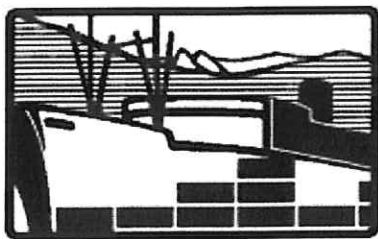
ILWU Canada's Negotiating Committee has authorized the ILWU Longshore Locals to conduct a strike vote

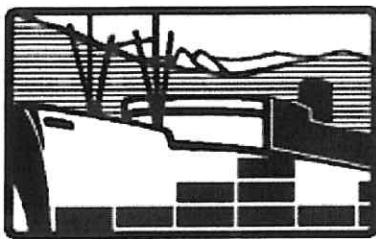

A message from your President regarding the upcoming strike vote...

Dear Brothers and Sisters

It is important that all Local 500 Members make every effort to show up to the May 8 and 9, 2019 strike vote and **VOTE YES**.

After more than 17 months since negotiations began, your Negotiating Committee needs your support now more than ever to get a fair deal for longshore workers; something you all deserve.

Voting YES to a strike does not mean you are voting to go on strike now. It means that the Union can go on strike in the next sixty days with 72-hours strike notice to the employer.

A YES vote gives your Negotiating Committee the support it needs to bring us closer to getting a new industry agreement deal without a strike. A strike vote is a common and useful part of the collective bargaining process and a strong mandate shows the employer that you are serious, and that you fully support your Negotiating Committee.

Come out and vote and **VOTE YES** for your future and to support your Negotiating Committee.
