Maximum Hours of Work (2496): to monitor this calculation refer to your cheque stubs. This number should not exceed 2496 hours for the contract year Jan 3/21 to Jan 1/22 inclusive. Total hours will be printed on your first cheque in 2021 (do not use your last 2020 cheque stub for total).

BCMEA Days: Are optional – you can use them to count towards Statutory Holiday Pay.

- Must report a minimum of four (4) days (unless you have less than 4 days left).
- Must be reported to the Union office NO LATER than seven (7) calendar days after the start of the vacation period.

- All vacation days can be called in, or a form can be found outside the office and dropped in the mail slot.

*** Final declaration must be reported no later than noon on December 24, 2021.**

Union Days: Do not need to be reported unless you want to prevent being fined for missing Union meetings / elections / votes. You may report just one (1) day.

FYI: When you book BCMEA vacation days they not only assist you to obtain a stat, they also credit your health and welfare hour bank and help to maintain your A or B coverage. If you are close to losing that coverage, consider booking some BCMEA vacation days to maintain your coverage even if there is no upcoming stat.
