What does the move mean for you?

With GreenShield as our new prescription drug administrator, you'll have a new card *and* the same coverage you enjoy today.

- Starting January 1, 2024, you will use your new WEBC-GreenShield prescription drug card and GreenShield ID number to pay for prescription drug expenses in the way that's most convenient for you:
 - By presenting your new card or ID number to your **pharmacy** (or prescription drug provider) for on-the-spot reimbursement; OR
 - By submitting a claim **online via our mobile app**, by **mail**, or **in person** at WEBC.
- Your current plan coverage (e.g., annual/lifetime maximums) stay the same so does your coverage.
- You can continue to submit health care and dental care expenses to WEBC for reimbursement in the same way you do today – your health and dental care claims administration is not changing.
