ILWU LOCAL 500 PENSIONERS' SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

**The deadline for applications is:
October 31st of the current year**

As a result of the successful 50/50 fundraising draw administered by the ILWU Vancouver Pensioners at the monthly meetings of Local 500, a decision was made by the Pensioners, and agreed to by the Local, to provide:

- two (2) \$1,000 scholarships, one being the "*Bill Kemp Memorial Scholarship*" in recognition of Bill's long service to Local 500 and ILWU Canada.

In addition to the above scholarships, several memorial scholarships have been created in memory of longtime longshore workers or their family members:

- \$1,000 annual "*Sante Urrico Memorial Scholarship*";
- \$1,000 annual "*Randy Archibald aka 'Randy Rampage' Memorial Scholarship*";
- \$1,000 annual "*2022-2031 Warren Paley Memorial Scholarship*";
- \$1,000 annual "*2022-2026 Ronald McCaw Memorial Scholarship*";
- One (1) \$1,000 "*Parveen Baryer Memorial Scholarship*";
- One (1) \$500 "*Parveen Baryer Memorial Scholarship*".

The above cited scholarships are administered by the Vancouver Pensioners through the Local 500 office. They are offered to the sons, daughters, and dependents of active Members in good standing, as well as the sons, daughters, and dependents of Deceased Members who were active and in good standing at the time of their death (**Local 500 Members only**).

The scholarships will be available to applicants for:

Vocational / Technical / Career or University Studies.

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY:

1. Applicants for scholarships must provide verification of relationship to a Local 500 Member in good standing.
2. Applicants must provide verification of acceptance into the program and a receipt showing monies paid.
3. A letter of successful completion may be required.
4. The lottery-style draw will be open to all applicants in programs from November 1st of the previous year, to the **draw deadline of October 31st of the current year**.
5. The program must be identified as a fulltime Vocational/Technical/ Career or University program.
6. The deadline for applications will be October 31st of the current year and the successful candidates will be selected by lottery draw at the Local 500 Annual Membership Meeting in November of the current year.
7. **Successful candidates will NOT be entitled to participate in future Pensioner scholarship draws. Only one winner per immediate family per year is permitted.**

APPLICATION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE LOCAL 500 OFFICE.

Note: The Local 500 Pensioners' Scholarship Program is completely separate from that of ILWU Canada.
